Can you use a power bank during a flight?

Regarding the use of power banks for charging devices during the flight, passengers are advised to check with their airline to confirm if this is permitted. In most cases, it is recommended to keep power banks switched off, and recharging the power bank itself during the flight is generally discouraged.

Can you carry a power bank on Emirates?

In contrast, the UAE's General Civil Aviation Authority (GCAA) permits passengers to carry power banks on UAE-based airlines such as Emirates, Etihad, Flydubai, and Air Arabia. However, there are specific rules that travellers must follow. The GCAA classifies power banks as spare batteries and are only permitted in carry-on luggage.

Can you bring powerbanks and batteries on international travel?

The first step to bringing powerbanks and batteries on international travel is to know the regulations. Check the regulations of the airline you'll be flying with, as well as the regulations of the countries you'll be visiting. Some airlines and countries have restrictions on the size and type of batteries and power banks you can bring on board.

Can you put a power bank in a bag?

Avoid using a power bank inside a bag as it can overheat. Power banks are treated the same way by most airlines because the rules come from safety bodies like IATA (International Air Transport Association) and the FAA (Federal Aviation Administration). The good news is that the important points are pretty straightforward.

How many power banks can you take on a plane?

Know the Limits: Most airlines allow up to two power banks per passenger, but some (like Delta) permit up to 20 spare batteries. Confirm with your airline to avoid surprises. Be Airport-Smart: In China and some EU countries, unmarked power banks or those without clear capacity labels may be confiscated.

Are power banks allowed in checked luggage?

Emirates' official 'Dangerous Goods Policy' states that power banks are only allowed in hand luggage. Similarly, Etihad Airways categorises power banks as loose or spare batteries, which must be placed in cabin luggage. For safety reasons, these items are strictly prohibited in checked baggage.
