Why are mobile network operators launching mobile broadband services in Tanzania?

With the launch of mobile broadband services in Tanzania, the mobile network operators have become the leading internet service providers. Operators are hoping for revenue growth in the mobile data services market, given that the voice market is almost entirely prepaid and average revenue per user for voice continues to fall.

Why is Tanzania the second-largest telecoms market in East Africa?

Tanzania is the second-largest telecoms market in East Africa behind Kenya. The country's telecoms sector contributed USD 859 million to real GDP in 2018, up from USD 672 million in 2014, an increase of 28%. This growth was attributed to the increase in mobile usage and the expansion of broadcasting and internet services.

Who owns extelecom in Tanzania?

The head office of Tanzania Telecommunications Company Limited at the Extelecom's Building in Samora Avenue, east of Kisumu. Currently the company is wholly owned by the Government. In 2001 the government of Tanzania sold 35% stake in the company and in 2016 to protect the firm, repurchased the stock to regain 100 percent ownership.

Who are the key players in the telecoms sector?

The key players in the telecoms sector are the two fixed-line operators, Tanzania Telecommunications Corporation (TTC), formerly known as Tanzania Telecommunications Company Limited (TTCL) and Zantel, along with seven operational mobile networks.

What is the role of TTC in Tanzania's data infrastructure?

Government, through the TTC, has played an active part in the development of Tanzania's data infrastructure. TTC, which has a mandate to develop telecoms services and manage infrastructure, was formed in January 2018 after the Government acquired Bharti Airtel's 35% stake in its predecessor, TTCL.

Who are the leading Internet providers in Tanzania?

They are Airtel, Halotel, Smile, Tigo, TTC, Vodacom and Zantel with market shares of 27%, 13%, 0.024%, 25%, 2%, 31% and 2% respectively. With the launch of mobile broadband services in Tanzania, the mobile network operators have become the leading internet service providers.
